

Rural STEM Initiative

The goal is to establish ongoing relationships with schools participating in the initiative to supplement their other STEM resources at no charge to the school and on a non-exclusive basis.

In May 2022, DHEDF announced the launch of a National STEM Initiative focused on Rural Schools.

Overview of the Initiative

Dee Howard International Education Foundation (DHEDF) is a Texas based national non-profit established in January 2022 whose mission is to develop (in collaboration with others) programming, resources, curricula, and initiatives to engage primarily underserved Pre-K thru 12 students in STEAM learning based on the use of automotive and/or aeronautical project-based learning pathways.

The DHEDF flagship program is the **DHEDF National Rural STEM**Initiative, launched in May 2022 and inspired by Terri Mynatt, the Principal /Teacher at the John Fredson School in Venetie, Alaska, population 166. There are no roads into this small village located one hundred miles north of the Artic Circle; the only access is by bush plane or dog sled. Terri, her students, and the community quickly became our heroes. Working with Terri we developed, in collaboration with other stakeholders, the **DHEDF National Rural STEM Initiative for Pre-K -12 students, teachers, and school administrators** to deliver Aerospace and Automotive STEAM resources to rural schools primarily through virtual programing. John Fredson School was our launch school. Currently the Initiative is in thirty-five schools in ten states and is continuing to add schools and states each school semester.
